

SS Frequently Asked Questions

Do you have to be a believer to be a part of a Sunday school class?

No. All classes are open to anyone.

Are the classes only for people who are very knowledgeable about the Bible?

No. Some people have spent most of their lives reading and studying the Bible. Others are brand new to studying the Bible. The classes will meet the needs of all people.

Do you have to be a church member to attend a Sunday school class?

No. You do not have to join the church to attend Sunday school class. In fact, many people will join a Sunday school class before they join the church. Enrollment in an adult Sunday school class will help you begin to make close friends and know what is going on at the church.

How do I find the best Adult Sunday school class?

We encourage folks to look at the class list as a starting point. Choose a class that fits your life stage. For example, you are married and your kids are teenagers. We have a class that fits that criteria.

Visit that class and if you want to try other classes that is great. We want you to find the class where you feel the most connected. Our teachers are very comfortable with people visiting several different classes before finding the right one for them.

I am rather quiet and don't like to talk in groups, are the classes lecture style or discussion style?

Each teacher has their own teaching style. Some will tend to lean more towards lecture and others prefer to get the class involved in discussion and group activities. If you visit a class that does not meet your style, please feel free to visit another class.

Will I be called on to lead in prayer, or to read the Bible out loud in class?

Our teachers are very aware that guests in their class may feel a little uncomfortable already. They would not call on you to share unless you have already let them know it is okay to do so.

We have greeters in the main lobby of the church and at the entrance to our Christian Life Center (CLC). The greeters will be glad to assist you to your class room and will help you take your children to their classrooms first.
