

## AM Sermon Notes

**Text:** *Genesis 3:6-7*

**Title:** *Fatal Attraction*

**Central Truth:** When we choose to disobey God's Word we ultimately harm ourselves while also missing out on God's best for us.

### I. v. 6: The Tumble

*There is a two-fold process taking place:*

1. v. 6a: **The Appeal of Sin** (c.f. *1st John 2:16*) The Apostle John describes three ways or categories of temptation.

1. **good for food** - (*The lust of the flesh*) physical level.
2. **pleasing to the eyes** (*The lust of the eyes*) emotional level
3. **desirable to make one wise** (*The pride of life*) intellectual or spiritual level

### 2. v. 6b: The Act of Sin

Eve was completely deceived by Satan's lies. However, in *1st Timothy 2:14* the Apostle Paul tells us that Adam was not deceived. His sin was willful and defiant. Thus theologically speaking the Bible places the greater guilt on him. As the spiritual head of the home Adam is held accountable for the fall (c.f. *Romans 5:12; 1st Corinthians 15:22*).

### II. v. 7: The Tragedy
