

## AM Sermon Notes

**Text:** *John 21:1-14*

**Title:** “*Dead Men Don’t Do Breakfast*”

**Central Truth:** Jesus is alive having forever defeated the power of sin and death, thus He is able to save us and lead us everyday!

### I. vv. 1-5 A Fruitless Night

v. 1: Sea of Tiberias - This is another name for the Sea of Galilee. It was also called Lake Gennesaret or Sea of Chinnereth.

v. 2: There were seven total disciples present. Though unnamed the Apostle John was present. His writing style was to never mention himself by name (*c.f. John 21:7*).

v. 5: Jesus’ question presupposes a negative answer.

### II. vv. 6-9: A Full Net

v. 6: It is interesting to notice that these experienced fishermen did not question or protest Jesus’ command to cast their net. The right side of the boat was right because it was God’s side.

vv. 7-8: Peter impulsively responds to John’s recognition of Jesus!

### III. vv. 10-14: A Faith-building Nourishment

v. 10: Jesus wanted the disciples to supplement the meal with some of their catch. He is always inviting us to participate with Him!

v. 12: KJV - dine, have breakfast (Greek - *ariston*) It means the first meal of the day. This was another command from Jesus!
